International applicants who are applying for financial aid are normally expected to have a score of 600 (100 iBT) on the TOEFL; iBT scores are required in order to be considered for a teaching assistantship.

Writing sample in language of specialization required for applicants seeking licensure in a foreign language. Ph.D. candidates must submit a writing sample: Write something about the kinds of problems you want to explore and how you think you would explore them at this point. Refer to bibliography that has informed your interest in the problems and in the ways you want to explore these problems.

Spring: October 15 (OTD and domestic post-professional M.S. only) Fall: January 15	GRE General test scores required of all applicants except Tufts undergraduates and alumni. Applicants should include a list of prerequisite courses taken. TOEFL score of 570 (88-89 iBT) required for international applicants.
